Suspected FMD: 9 February 2021*

Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD) is a highly contagious viral disease affecting mammals and has a great potential for causing severe economic loss. It affects cloven-hoofed animals.

A suspected outbreak of Foot and mouth disease was reported from Gengu village, Darla gewog, Chhukha dzongkhag. As per the flash report shared, clinical cases were observed since 8 February 2021 and a total of 5 cattle and 5 goats were affected; no mortality was reported.

To prevent further spread of the suspected disease, all the measures - in line with the National FMD Prevention and Control Plan 2020 - have been put into place by the Dzongkhag Livestock Sector, Chhukha. For confirmation of the suspected disease, required samples have been referred to the NCAH.
