- 4. Freedom from pain, injury and diseases.
- 5. Freedom from fear and distress.

DID YOU KNOW???

According to Section 20.2 of the Livestock Act of Bhutan 2001, your pet dog must be registered, identified, and vaccinated against rabies and other diseases.



PET OWNERS MUST ALWAYS TAKE THE FOLLOWING RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Register your pet dog and update the details regularly.
- Microchip your pet dog.
- Sterilize your pet dog and vaccinate against rabies and other diseases.
- Ensure to meet five freedoms for your pet dog.
- Abide by The Livestock Act of Bhutan 2001 and the Livestock Rules and Regulations of Bhutan 2017.
